### **Logistics Operation:**

- Check Site Operation March 28, 2020 at 6:30 pm
- Lock Down Operation April 6, 2020 at 12:00 am
- Enforcement with NAPS/Enforcement Officer
- 24/7 Security
- No Access IN or OUT during Lock Down Operation
- <u>Essential services only</u>- .e.g. Health Staff, CATC staff, Post Office, Curb Side Delivery Trucks, EMS, NAPS, OPP, Kunuwanimano CFS, Service providers for emergencies only

- All Information provided to CLFN COVID-19 Task Force is by the World Health Organization and Public Health Agency of Canada.
- Medical van protocol completed and in effect
- Prescriptions pick up by Medical van, call clinic in advance
- Quarantine Site Protocol
